1. Introduction

What is an APC Programme?

An APC Programme is a business' way of professionally supporting its candidates on their APC journey, with an end goal of reaching RICS chartership and becoming a Member of the RICS (MRICS).

At TSA Riley, the focus is on ensuring that candidates feel supported in their APC journey arming them with the tools and support they need, while giving them the flexibility and control of the process. In addition to a Counsellor, candidates have access to dedicated Office Coaches, who are senior chartered staff, along with fellow candidates and the APC Programme Director. This approach enables candidates to access a wide range of expertise within the business, all focused on supporting them on their APC journey.

2. Our APC Programme

Our APC Programme

Since our programme was relaunched in **2018** we are very pleased to have coached **over 55** Candidates with a further **40** enrolled at present.

The APC process involves candidates enrolling onto the programme, receiving guidance from mentors through assignments and quarterly training sessions, undergoing a pre-qualification process, and ultimately aiming to achieve chartered status, enabling them to become mentors themselves.



1. Enrolling onto the Programme

We make taking the first step easy with support and guidance from a line manager, candidates would normally enrol onto the programme two years from the date that they would be taking their final assessment (subject to pathway).



2. Assignment of a counsellor

All our in-house mentors have recent first-hand experience of the final assessment and have undertaken both TSA Riley's inhouse counsellor training and the RICS' counsellor training, ensuring they are best placed to help their candidates.



3. Quarterly training sessions

During these sessions, candidates from across our UK offices come together for a full day's training workshop covering various aspects of the final assessment which include Q&A's, interactive sessions and a guest speaker.



4. Pre-Qualification process

The candidate will meet with their Supervisor and Counsellor to go through the prequalification process to help them prepare for the final assessment.



5. Get Chartered!

Congratulations you are now chartered in your chosen field. You can now go on to become a mentor and support someone through their journey.




